Framework - 3Ds

- Discover educational resources already available
 - Review and update as needed
 - Identify and "borrow" other sources/material
- Develop material to fill gaps
 - Focus on priority / problem areas
 - Use multi-media, seasonal messages
 - Incorporate ideas from previous Wake Committee
- Deliver educational information and material
 - Use media targeted to audience, increase social
 - Leverage press, news, business, community channels
 - Use Lake Patrol / Enforcement as front line delivery

Approach

- Form subcommittes for each "D" and Enforcement
- Develop prioritized list of target areas, based on initial recommendations by Enforcement
- Catalog existing information and material
- Benchmark other lakes

Preliminary Priorities

- Rental Boats and Homes
 - Four Deaths in 2020
 - No license / education requirement
- Jet Skiers
 - No wake violations, unsafe maneuvers
 - Overloaded skis / tubes
 - Vacationers, renters, underage, untrained
- Fishers
 - Tournament visitors violate no wake
- Wake Surfers
 - Incorporate / expand recommendation from Wake Surfing Study Committee
